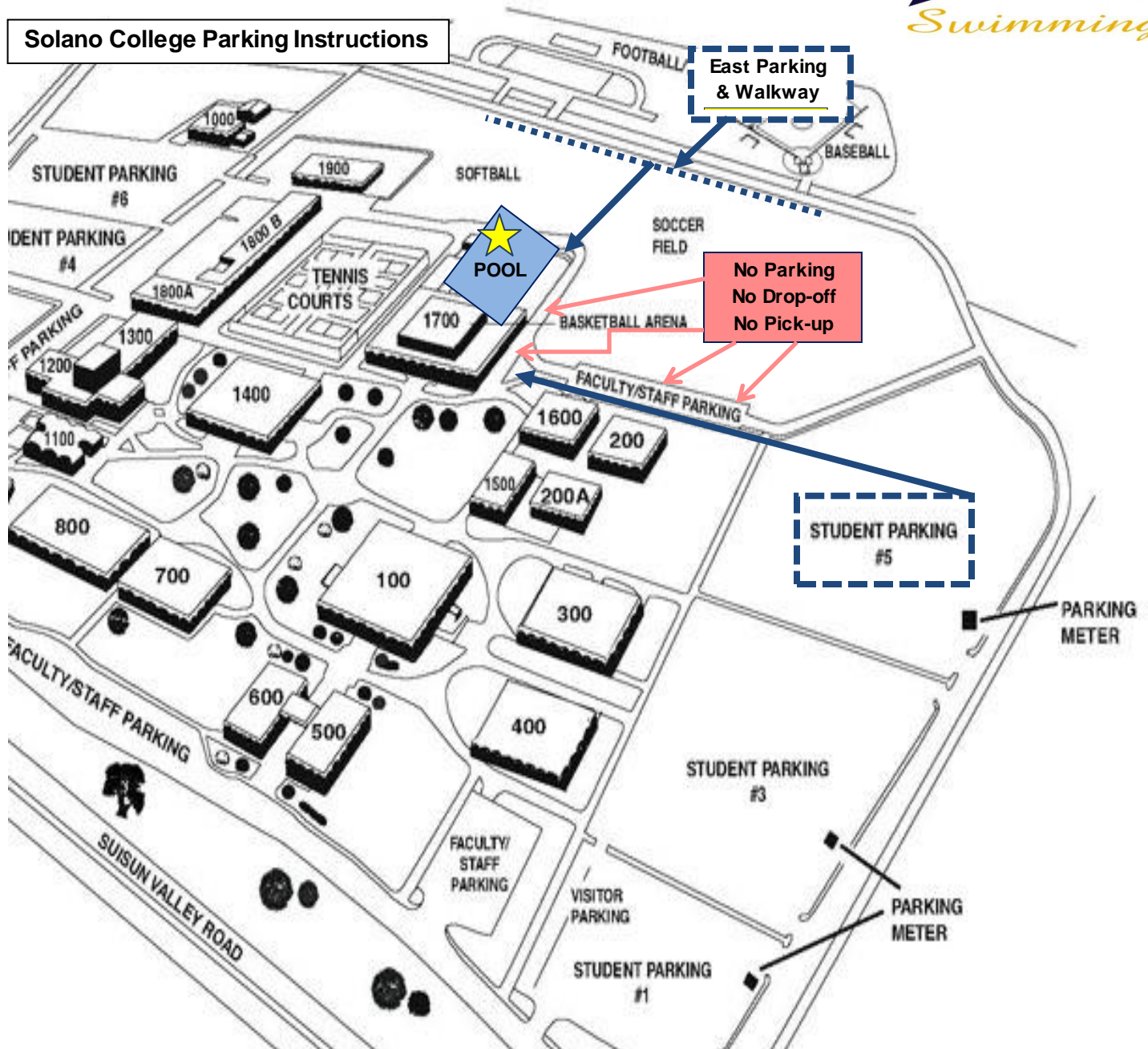


## Solano College Parking Instructions



### Parking Permits

Community or Student Parking Permits are required everywhere on campus.

**Contact SASO for information on purchasing semester parking permits at Solano Community College**

Swimmers participating in the week free trial should get daily parking permits. \*Daily parking permits may be purchased at parking meters located in each student lot for \$1/daily (4 quarters may be required).

Semester community parking permits can be purchased at the Community Services Office. **Due to campus construction, the office location and times are TBA. Please contact a SASO representative during your week trial at the pool for updated information.**

Parents are asked to park in **LOT 5**, but can park in any "student lot" when dropping their child off for swim practice. Parking is not permitted in the Faculty/Staff lots or the roundabout. Please observe the speed limit while driving on campus.

### Swimmer pick-up, Be Prompt

To ensure the safety of all SASO swimmers, swimmers will not be released from the pool area until a parent or designated adult/carpool driver collects them from practice. Swimmers will NOT be able to leave the pool area: visit locker rooms, change, shower, etc., until they are released by the coach to a responsible adult.

### No Dogs on Campus

Solano College has a strict "no dogs" policy. Except for service animals, dogs are prohibited from being on campus. This includes dogs left in cars. Do not bring your dog to the pool area before, during, or after swim practice.

From Solano Community College:

Parents can complete the parking permit form and purchase parking permits in-person anytime between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. Fall/Spring parking permits are \$20. Cash, check, or money order is accepted.

The new parking permit will not be valid until the first day of classes on August 17. Campus police will continue to enforce parking in faculty lots daily, but campus police will begin enforcing student parking on Monday, August 31. **Parking permits and daily passes are valid only in student parking lots.**

**Driver Responsibilities**  
It is the responsibility of every driver to know and obey the Solano Community College District parking regulations and the California Vehicle Code. The parking regulations can be found at <http://www.solano.edu>. The Solano Community College Parking Regulations and the California Vehicle Code are enforced at all times. All reserved spaces require special permits. Any vehicle not properly parked or not in compliance with Solano Community College Parking regulations is subject to citation and possible tow-away.

**Parking Permits**  
A Solano Community College Parking permit is required on any vehicle parked on any part of the Solano Community College Fairfield campus, Vallejo Center or Vacaville Center during the following hours (Faculty, staff, and reserved spaces are enforced 24 hours):  
Monday – Friday 7 AM to 10 PM  
Saturday & Sunday No Permit Required  
College Holidays No Permit Required

**Parking permits are transferable from vehicle to vehicle, not person to person, and shall be affixed to the inside lower-left corner of the front windshield. Permit hangers are not allowed.**
